On July 20th, 2021, Susan O'Neill, from Ballyea, died from cancer. On November 11th, 2021 Antoinette Pender from Quilty also died having contracted cancer. Both women fought bravely.

The two charities that will benefit from the cycle are Slainte an Chlair and Cancer Care West. Slainte an Chlair is based in Kilnamona and has provided support to cancer patients for many years. Cancer Care West is based in Galway and has supported cancer patients along the western seaboard to access care as well as helping support new therapy development, research & education in cancer and leukaemia care.
